

## **CONTEST TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

**Refers to the contest organized as part of the second edition of the Conference "Future cities" on April 11, 2019 in the Copernicus Science Center in Warsaw**

### **§1. General provisions**

1. The organizer of the Competition is Sweco Consulting Sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Poznań, 60-829, ul. Roosevelta 22 (hereinafter the "Organizer").
2. The competition will be held at the end of the second edition of the conference "Future cities", on April 11, 2019, in the conference room of the Copernicus Science Center in Warsaw (hereinafter: "Conference Room").

### **§2. Eligibility**

1. The participants of a contest are all people who are present at the Conference Room at the time of asking questions (hereinafter: "Participants").
2. Employees of the Organizer are not eligible to take part in the Contest.
3. By participating in the Contest, the Participants accept the Terms and Conditions and confirm fulfillment of the Contest requirements.

### **§3. Winner selection**

1. The Contest is aimed to select three people among the Participants who are the first to provide a correct answer for the Contest questions (hereinafter: "Winners").

### **§4. Announcement of the results**

1. Winners will be announced immediately after the Contest by the Organizer or by other person on behalf of the Organizer.

### **§5. Prizes**

1. A Prize is provided for the Winner. In total, three Winners will be selected.
2. The Prize for each Winner is one copy of the book (in Polish) entitled "Nauka o klimacie" ("Science about the climate") by Marcin Popkiewicz, Aleksandra Kardaś and Szymon Malinowski.
3. The Prize is sponsored by the Organizer.
4. The Prize will be given to each of the three Winners after the end of the Contest.
5. The Winner is obliged to collect the Prize personally, immediately after the Contest results are announced. Otherwise, the prize will be handed over to the next person who provided the correct answer.

## **§6. Final Provisions**

1. The Organizer reserves the right to terminate or suspend the Contest with or without any prior notice and reason.
2. Participants are not entitled to submit any claim for an undue Prizes.
3. The Participant may rise a claim regarding the procedures of the Contest by the end of the day of the Conference, April 11, 2019.
